Many Protestants stumble over calling their faith catholic. The word catholic means universal. This creed states the universal faith of all true believers, thus calling true faith the catholic faith. We must not confuse the word catholic with the Church of Rome (Catholic Church). The catholic faith is the faith of all true believers.
