Mid-Week Bible Study, Wednesday mornings, 9:15 in the Church Basement. We are studying the Book of Romans. All are welcome.

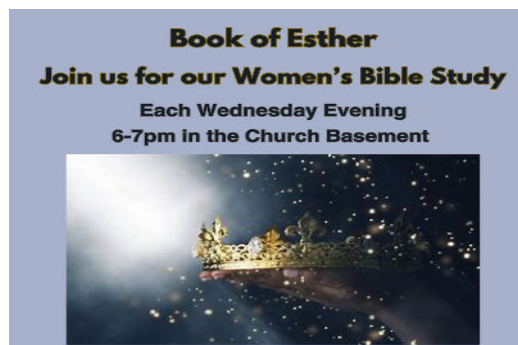
Men's Bible Study - Invite a Friend
